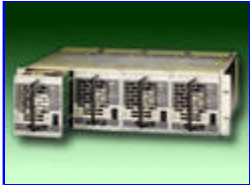

Ignorance Rules

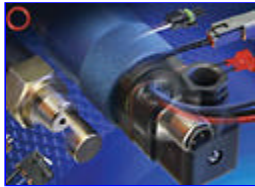
